



Extension to Deed of Grant

The Grant of Exclusive Rights of Burial is issued for the period stated on the Exclusive Right of Burial Deed and may be renewed up to a total maximum of 50 years. The Deed will state when the Rights were issued and how long for.

A registered owner can apply to the Stamford Town Hall Bereavement Services at any time to extend the Deed at a minimum of 10 years at the relevant cost see *Fees and Charges*.

To extend the Rights to a grave, the registered owner can complete this form and return to Stamford Town Hall Bereavement Services.

Once the Rights have expired, the ownership reverts to the Burial Authority (Stamford Town Council). If the Rights have expired, you can still apply to purchase the plot.
