NOTICE OF VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF COUNCILLOR
FOR ST. GEORGE WARD

1. There is a vacancy on the Council caused by the **sad death of Councillor Bill Turner (Town Mayor)**.....
2. A by-election to fill the vacancy will be held if within 14 days (not counting a Saturday or Sunday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Good Friday, or a Bank Holiday) from the date below ten electors for the ward/parish give notice in writing claiming such an election to the Returning Officer.

Signed requests for an election should be sent by email to elections@southkesteven.gov.uk. A photograph or scanned copy of a signed letter will be acceptable.

4. Where ten valid requests for a by-election are received by the Returning Officer, under the provisions of the Coronavirus Act 2020 and The Local Government and Police and Crime Commissioner (Coronavirus) (Postponement of Elections and Referendums) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020 the by-election will not currently take place, and the vacancy will be held open until the by-election takes place. The 2020 regulations provide for the by-election to take place on 6 May 2021. However, this date may be brought forward or deferred by the Government depending upon the circumstances. Any election that is called will be duly publicised as required by law.
5. If an election is not requested, the Town Council will fill the vacancy by co-option.
