Purchase of Exclusive Rights of Burial

Purchasing a grave does not mean you own the plot of land. When purchasing the rights to a grave, you are purchasing the lease for 50 years and the exclusive right to choose who can be buried in the grave during that period.

Notes

1. Revised charges to be applied to all burials from 1st April 2020.
2. Non-Resident Charges will apply where the deceased was living outside of Stamford at the time of their death. Exceptions to the rule are as follows:
 - 2.1. If a burial plot has been purchased by a Stamford resident who subsequently leaves the Town and is the residing outside of Stamford at the time of their death.
 - 2.2. Stamford residents that have needed to move out of the Town to receive specialist care e.g. a nursing home or move in with a family member for care support – up to a period of 10 years from the date of moving out of the Town. NB Those who move out of Stamford to downsize or to move closer to relatives will not be eligible for this exception.
 - 2.3. Members of the Armed Forces (the serving individual and their spouse – married or co-habiting partner)
3. Charges include all necessary documentation.
4. Refer to full guidance notes for information regarding the ERB (Exclusive Right of Burial) processes in place regarding re-erection of safety test failed memorials and other remedial works.
5. Non-resident fee will be applied to any memorial request on an unpurchased plot.
6. Burial times at Stamford Cemetery –

Monday to Friday – 10.00am – 4.00pm - 1st April till end of BST (British Summer Time)

10.00am - 3.00pm – GMT (Greenwich Mean Time) till 31st March
