FEES AND CHARGES FOR EXTRA LARGE CASKETS - WITH EFFECT FROM 1st APRIL 2019

Standard charges apply to:

- A person who, immediately before death or when purchasing a plot, was a resident in Stamford.
• A Burial in a previously purchased reserved plot or second burial in an existing plot.
• Children of parents currently residents in Stamford.
• A person who, prior to death, was resident in hospital, home for the elderly, chronically ill or similar and, who immediately before removal to such place, was resident in Stamford.
• A person returning to be buried with a spouse already interred with a purchased plot.

NOTES:

- A. Plots maybe reserved prior to death on payment to Stamford Town Council of the Plot Fee (Exclusive Rights apply for 50 years from the date of the grant).
B. Burials in Reserved Plots & second burials in the same plot require payment of the Burial Fee only
C. Standard terms and conditions apply.

Double Charges apply to:
