FINANCE & GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE

The Committee regulates, manages and controls the finances and resources of the Council, including the recommendation to Council of the annual budget and precept in accordance with Financial Regulations. Finance & Governance Committee also considers matters of policy and governance and has delegated authority to manage expenditure against the Council's Administration Budget.

ASSETS & SERVICES COMMITTEE

The Committee manages and monitors the provision of Council's land and property assets and those services directly provided or commissioned by the Council. Assets & Services Committee has the delegated authority to manage expenditure against the Council's Assets & Services Budget.

CIVIC & COMMUNITY COMMITTEE

The Committee meets to consider civic functions, the provision of grants and to support and develop opportunities for engagement with other community stakeholders and to raise the profile of the services provided by the Town Council. The Civic & Community Committee has the delegated authority to manage expenditure against the Council's Civic & Community Budget.

PLANNING COMMITTEE

The Committee meets as a statutory consultee of the planning authority, to consider all planning applications received from South Kesteven District Council and make recommendations on behalf of the Town Council.

HERITAGE & COLLECTIONS COMMITTEE

The Committee meets to consider the management and development of the Town Hall and its collections, the transfer of the Stamford Collection held by Lincolnshire County Council, Escape Room attraction within the Town Hall, the delivery of a Museum for Stamford. Heritage & Collections Committee has the delegated authority to manage expenditure against the Council's Heritage & Collections Budget.

CLIMATE & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

The Committee meets to promote projects and ideas across the town that will support the Climate plan in terms of mitigation and adaptation to develop social, economic and environment resilience.
