

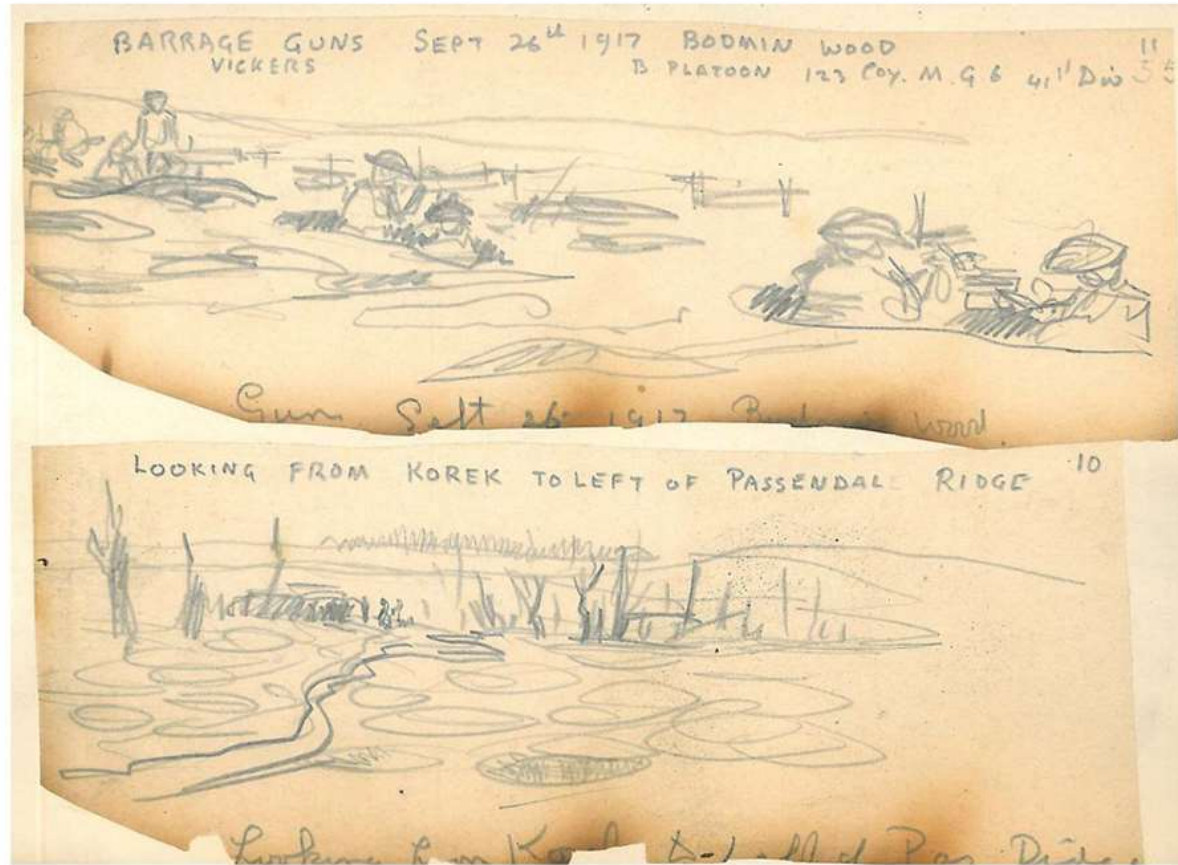

This pencil sketch by Wilfrid Wood effectively conveys the soldier's view of the theatre of war.





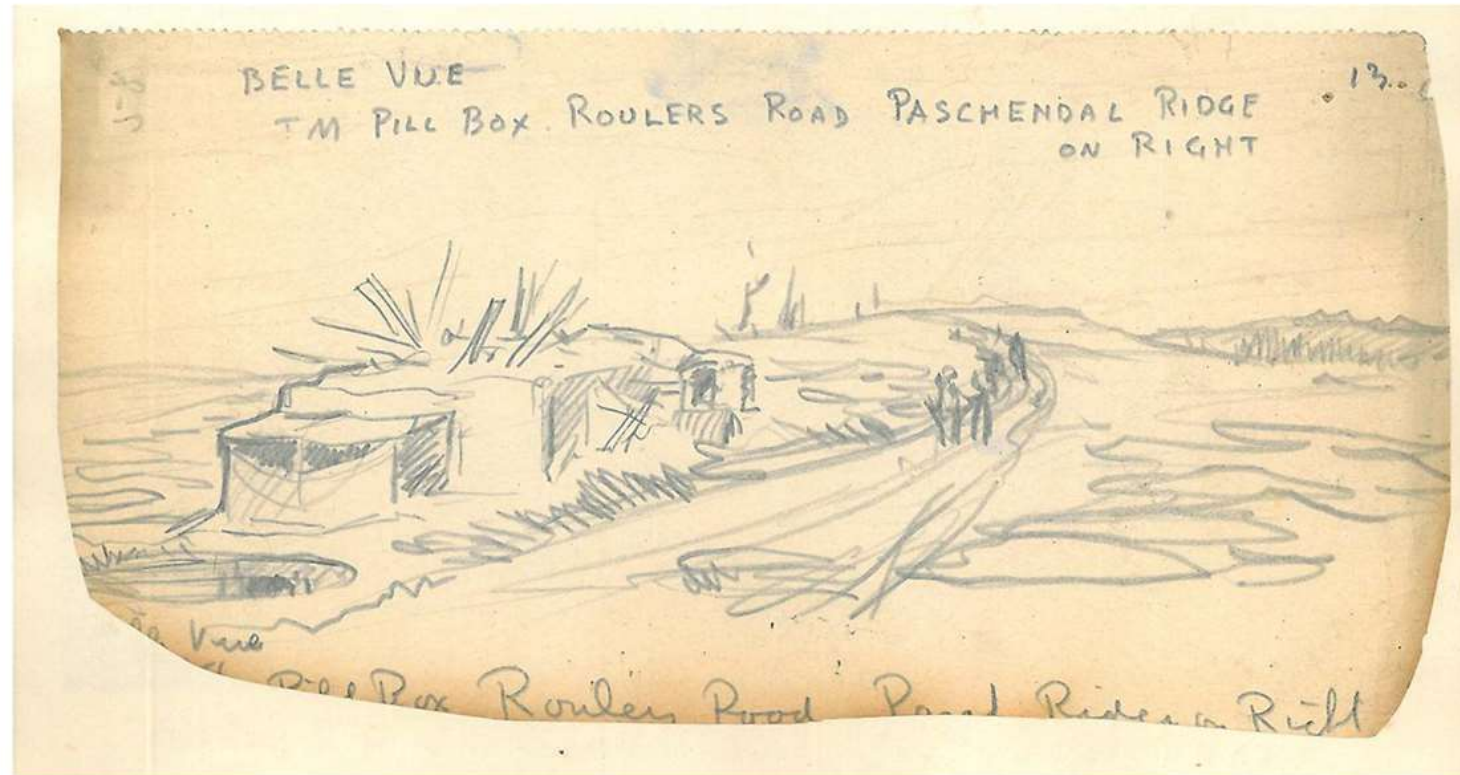
Mores scenes of war torn landscapes and the Front Line,

Drawing by local artist Wilfrid Wood, made whilst serving near Ypres in 1916. An insight into what awaited those new recruits when they arrived on the Front Line.





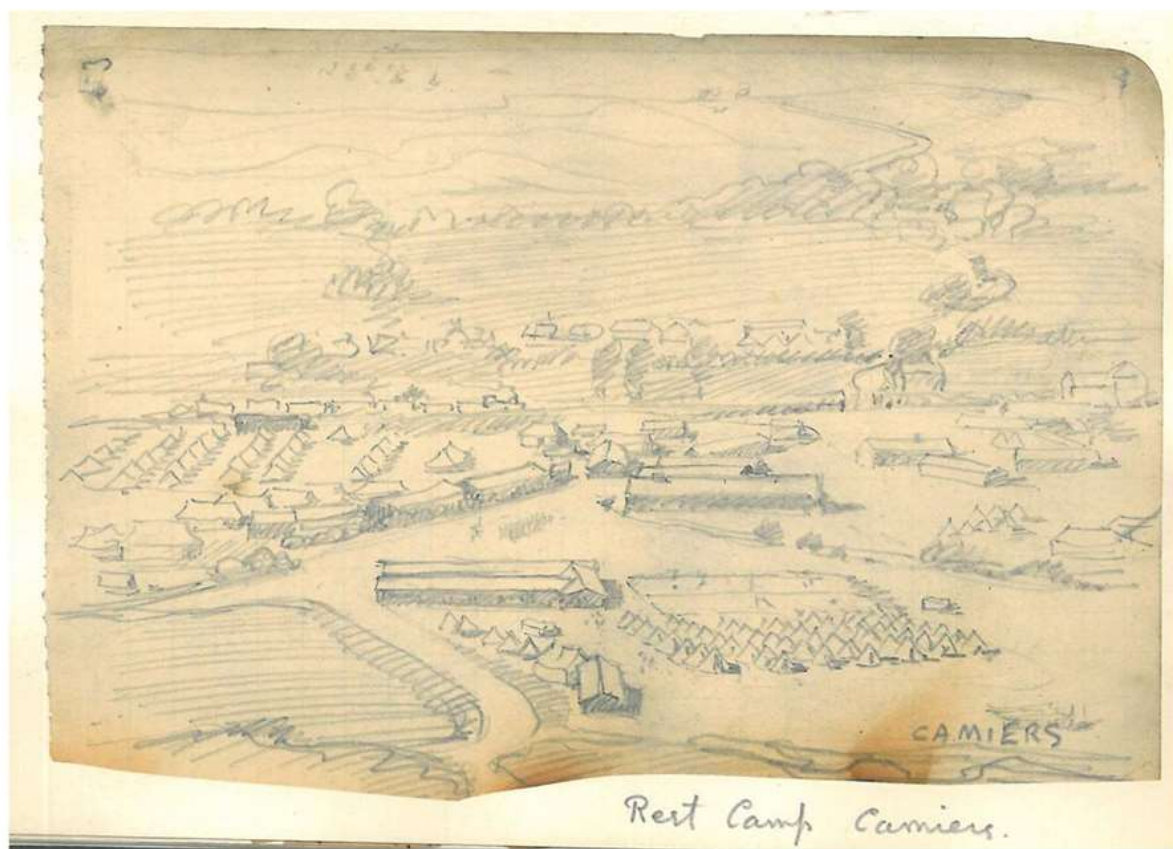
Pencil sketch made by Wilfrid Wood whilst serving on the notorious Paschendale Campaign.

Shrapnel on Montello 1918. A vivid depiction of life under fire on the front line, by Wilfrid Wood.





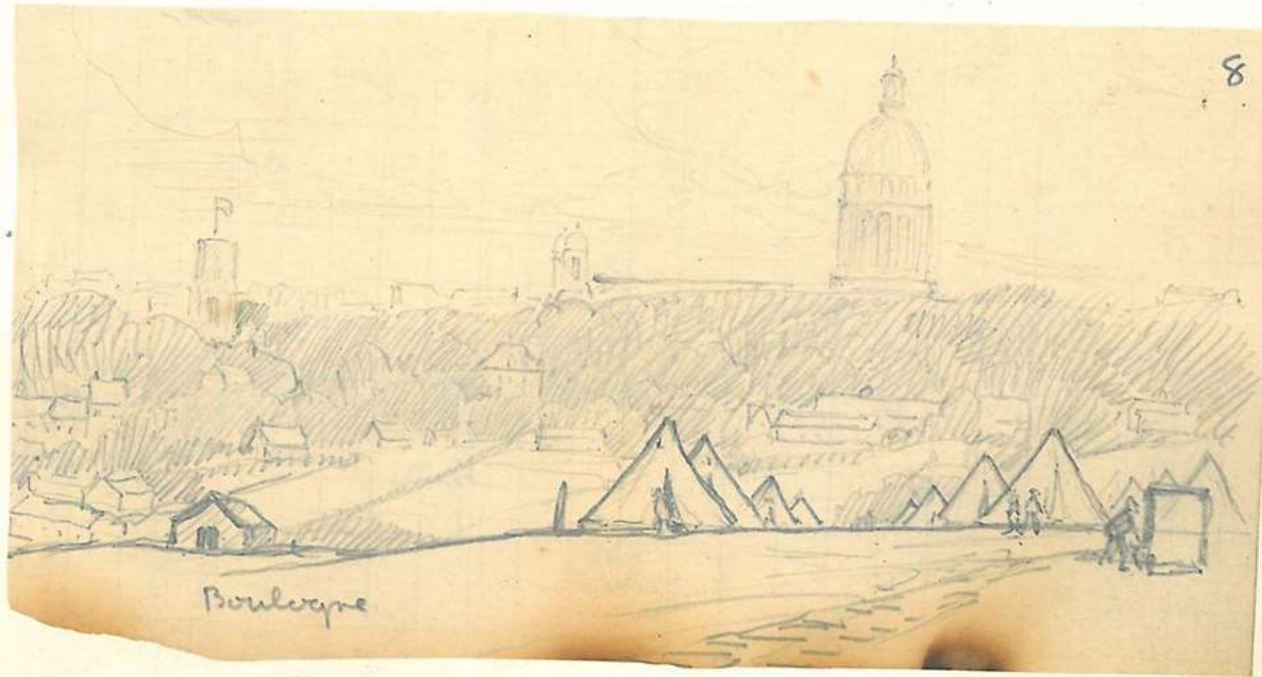

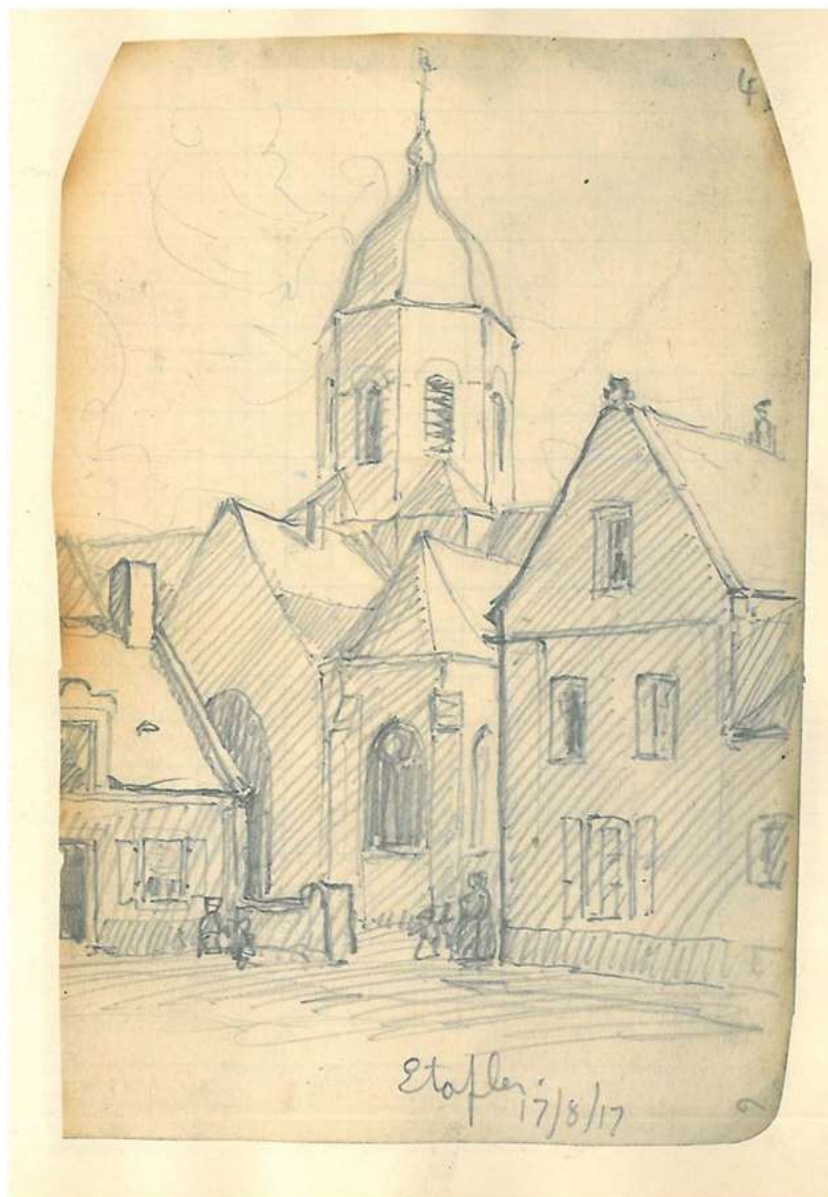
