**ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF ROAD IMPROVEMENTS  
SCHEME: RED LION SQUARE STAMFORD**

I am writing to inform you that work on the Red Lion Square improvement project is due to start on Tuesday 3 May 2022 and will take up to sixteen weeks to complete, subject to suitable weather.

Eurovia Contracting North has been appointed as the scheme Contractor.

**Description of Works**

The proposed works are within the carriageway area of Red Lion Square and include replacing the existing stone paving and carriageway foundation.

**Benefits**

The proposed project will address the existing structural issues by providing a new paved surface that has the following benefits:

- The new paving will be aesthetically sympathetic and very similar to the existing paving.
- The new paving will have a design life of up to 20 years.
- The new paving will have thicker stone setts, set on a new concrete foundation with mortar bed and joints, which will reduce on-going maintenance costs.

**Traffic Management**

Please be assured that pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the entire scheme and arrangements will be made to accommodate deliveries to shops and premises during the construction works.

The current traffic management proposal includes maintaining northbound traffic flow only through Red Lion Square, with a closure and signed diversion route in place for southbound traffic.

A full road closure of Red Lion Square, including the western end of the High Street, will also be in place for approximately two weeks during the project to allow for the safe working of the

construction staff. The date for this will be confirmed closer to the time. For those properties sited directly within the extents of the road closure, please be aware, this will be a live construction site and the road surface may not be up to its usual standard.

***Advance Warning signs will be erected on site two weeks prior to the date of any of the various traffic restrictions.***
