

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH
VARIOUS ROADS
SPEED LIMIT AMENDMENT ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that The Council of the City of Peterborough proposes to make the above mentioned Order under Sections 82(2)(b), 83(2) and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, 'the Act of 1984' and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of this Order is to:

- a) reduce the speed limit from 50mph to 40mph along the length of London Road (B1081), St Martins Without, from a point 80m south of its junction with First Drift to a point 40m north of the Bottle Lodges entrance to Burghley House.
- b) reduce the speed limit on Kettering Road (A43) Wothorpe from the national speed limit to 40mph from a point 70.5m south of its junction with Second Drift to a point 245m south of its junction with Second Drift,
- c) introduce a 20mph speed limit along the full length of Moggswell Lane.
