	<p>Update - A1 Sibbington                      I am writing with an update on the work we're carrying out to replace the brick retaining wall alongside the Old Great North Road and the safety barrier on the A1 southbound.                      Our work is progressing well. Following some programme changes due to other roadworks in neighbouring areas, we now expect our work to be complete by Friday 7 October.                      We will continue to work during the day to complete the brick retaining wall replacement and resurfacing work.                      To complete the safety barrier replacement work, we will need to close the A1 southbound overnight between Wansford and Junction 17 between 8pm and 6am from Tuesday 6 September to Friday 7 October, weeknights only. It may be necessary to stand down our work due to other works in the area, however we aim to complete the work as soon as possible.                      Whilst the A1 southbound is closed, traffic will be diverted from the A1 at Wansford and directed to follow A47, A1260 New Parkway, A1139 Fleton Parkway, before re-joining the A1(M) southbound at Junction 17, Fleton Parkway Interchange.                      Tree planting                      We will be replacing the two trees we removed earlier this year adjacent to the Sibbington Centre. Four new trees will be planted on Monday 12 September near to where the old trees were located. All closures for roadworks on motorways in and out of London will be passed from now until after the State Funeral on Monday 19 September. This includes on motorways such as the M5, M1, M6, M6 and M25.                      Additionally, all other closures on the motorway network nationally will be postponed for the duration of the extended bank holiday weekend. Existing roadworks will also be removed where possible, with cones and temporary signage withdrawn from site on Friday 16 September and not put back in place until Tuesday 20 September.                      Regarding the scheme we recently contacted you about in the email below, we will be working as planned during the daytime of Friday 16 September but no work will be carried out overnight. There will also be no work carried out on Monday 19 September. Work will resume as planned on Tuesday 20 September.
